

Exit the Visitor Centre and follow the signs alongside the Sheep Barn and Calf House to the end of the track. Go through the gate into the Park, noticing the Roman Villa site on your left. Continue to walk round Coe's Wood (planted in 1983) turning left at the end. Pass through the gate, turn right onto the track for 100m, keeping the deer paddock with young deer on your left, then turn left along the hedge back towards the farm.

Discovery & Archaeology Trails

Walk our **Discovery Trail** (1.5 miles) and see an abundance of diverse wildlife and habitats or discover the rich archaeology of Snettisham Park on the **Archaeology Trail** (2.5 miles). You'll also breathe some very fresh country air!

Please collect the leaflets for these Trails from the Visitor Centre.

Enjoy Snettisham Park Safely

- **¥** No food or drink to be taken into the farm.
- Always wash your hands thoroughly after touching the animals, before eating or drinking and again before you leave the farm.

- ¥ Cover any cuts or abrasions with a waterproof plaster.
- Pregnant women are strongly advised not to visit the sheep barn during lambing.
- Please do not taste any of the foodstuffs or drink from any taps.
- **¥** Please observe safety information posters at all times.
